

The Butterfly Project Submitted by Sue Hallmark, Havana Junior High, Havana, IL

During this project, students use rubber bands to enlarge photographs of butterflies available at the Butterflies of Illinois website.

Procedure:

Tie a knot in the middle of a rubber band. Securely anchor one end of the rubber band (at Point P) to form an anchor point. Place a pencil through the other end of the rubber band and position the knot above a part of the figure. Move the knot over the various parts of the figure using the pencil to trace the enlargement.

NOTE: This is not a truly accurate method of enlarging figures. Student should discover that the picture is doubled, or enlarged by a scale factor of 2.

Challenge students to experiment with this method by placing the knot at various points along the rubber band - closer to or further away from the anchor point.
